

Kohrville Elementary Party Guidelines

The PFO has established the following party guidelines:

1. Kohrville Elementary will have two school-wide parties; Winter Holiday & Valentine's Day
2. A snack will be provided from school or PFO funds that follows the USDA Free and Reduced food guidelines. No food products, including those attached to cards, may be brought in by guests or teachers for consumption during the parties.
3. A common gift will be purchased from school or PFO funds for all students at each grade level and must be approved by the principal or designee. Students may not bring food or gifts to share with classmates at school parties. Equality in items students receive is to be maintained across the school.
4. Guests may attend the party and must check in through the front office and be prepared to provide a Driver's License or a State ID. Snacks and gifts will not be provided for the guests in the room, including younger siblings.
5. PFO will distribute the snack, drink and gift to each classroom prior to start of the party.
6. Games are encouraged as activities during the party. Prizes and/or game pieces may be awarded as part of the activity.
7. Money may not be collected from the students for the party.
